Suspension of JIS Q 9100/ ISO 9001 Certifications to be Rescinded at Mitsubishi Electric's Communication Systems Center

TOKYO, March 17, 2023 – [Mitsubishi Electric Corporation](https://www.mitsubishielectric.com) (TOKYO: 6503) announced today, that effective March 17, 2023, per a special audit, Defense Structure Improvement Foundation will rescind the suspension of the certification under the JIS Q 9100/ ISO 9001 international standard for quality management systems at the company's Communication Systems Center (Amagasaki-city, Hyogo Prefecture). The Defense Structure Improvement Foundation suspended this certification on January 13, 2023, in connection with the certain quality-related conduct at the center, as announced on October 20, 2022.

The JIS Q 9100 is an international standard for quality management systems specific to the aerospace and defense industry and the ISO 9001 certification is an international standard for quality management systems.
