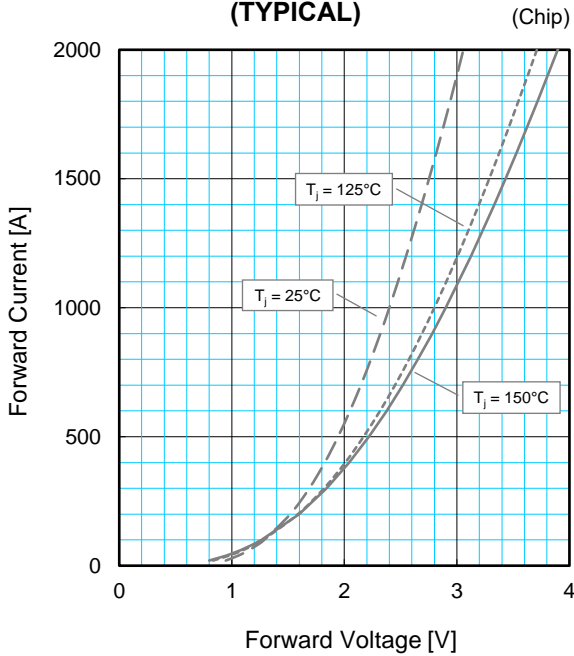

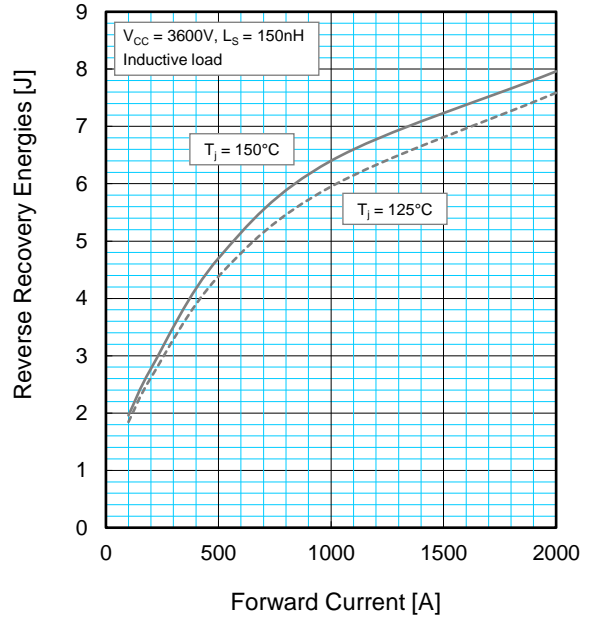

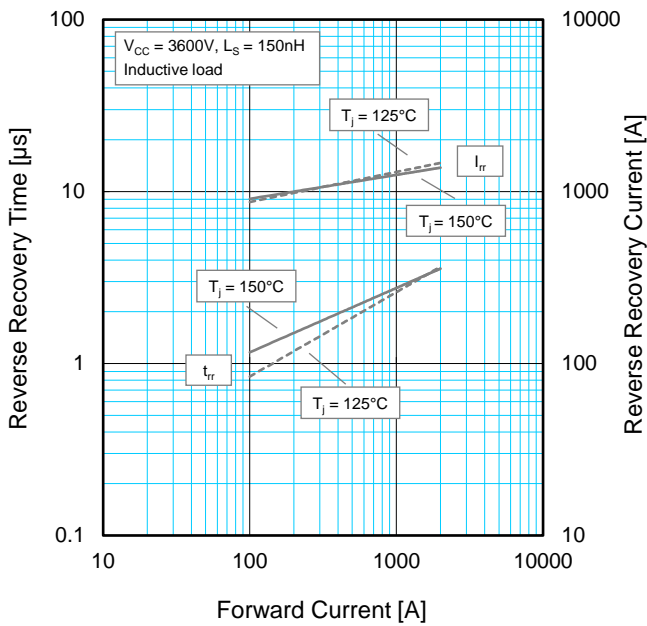
FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)



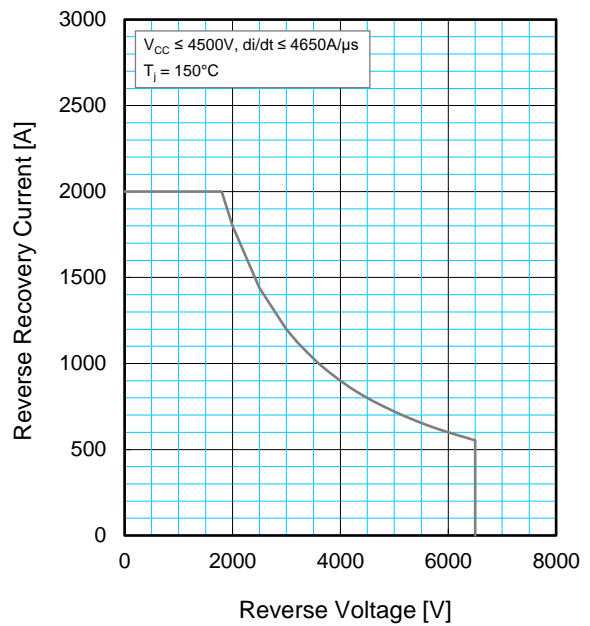
REVERSE RECOVERY ENERGY CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)



REVERSE RECOVERY CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)

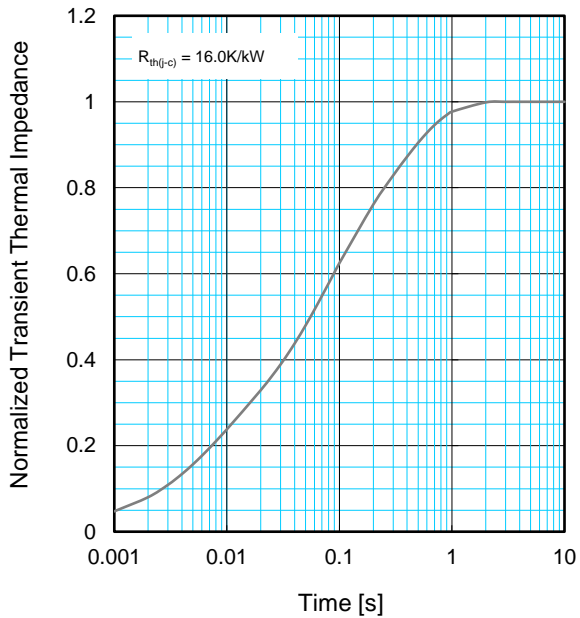


REVERSE RECOVERY SAFE OPERATING AREA (RRSOA)
