



- If you install this product while running the PWS (Personal Web Server) or resident software such as antivirus software, [ComponentMoveData Error Information] will be displayed and the product may not be installed properly. In case of the error, close the software and restart the personal computer, and then try installing the product again. If you stop antivirus software, a risk of virus infection will increase on the personal computer. Restart the antivirus software immediately after installation.
- The following screen will appear when the product is installed for the first time or the USB Driver is installed. In this
 case, click "Continue Anyway" and continue the installation.
 (We have checked the operation and assured that the system operates without any problem by performing this
 procedure.)
