## ■ Confirm before installation

- For PX Developer (SW1D5C-FBDQ-E), Programming Tool and Monitor Tool are installed.
- For PX Developer Monitor Tool (SW1DNC-FBDQMON-E), only Monitor Tool is installed.
- PX Developer and PX Developer Monitor Tool cannot be installed on the same personal computer.
- Log on to the personal computer as an administrator.
- Close all running applications before installation. If the product is installed while other applications are running, it may not operate normally.

## ■ Installation

This product can be used after it has been installed in the personal computer according to the following procedure.

- 1. Insert the product CD-ROM to the CD-ROM drive. Double-click "setup.exe" in the CD-ROM.
- 2. Select or enter the necessary information by following the on-screen instructions.


Product ID is written on the "License certificate" included in this product. Enter the 12-digit number divided into 3 and 9 digits.

If the confirmation screen appears during the installation, continue the installation according to the instruction on the screen.

If any of the following screens appears, perform the operation instructed for respective screens.

(Screen 1) Select "Allow" or "Yes".

User Account Control helps stop unauthorized changes to your computer




(Screen 2) Select "Install this driver software anyway".




The following screens may appear after the installation is completed.

(Screen 3) Restart the personal computer according to the instruction on the screen.



(Screen 4) Select "This program installed correctly". Do not choose "Reinstall using recommended settings", because the installer installs an incorrect module.
