Seamlessly integrated with its timeless theme of ancient Roman luxury, the spiral escalators flow through the atrium of the premier shopping mall annex to Caesar's Palace in graceful arcs. Long a dream of architects and engineers, the world's first practical spiral escalator was successfully developed by Mitsubishi Electric in 1985*. Today almost 100 Mitsubishi Electric spiral elevators add a touch of magic to locations around the world, but this impressive helical structure stands out, spanning 3 floors with four elevators in a continuous two-tier configuration. This masterpiece of engineering is ingeniously supported by hidden beams to create the appearance of floating on air, while high-quality maintenance service ensures 24H trouble-free operation in the city that never sleeps. Flawlessly moving people vertically and emotionally, the Mitsubishi Spiral Escalator is an integral part of the building interior and a wonder that will delight visitors for many years to come.
