Discontinued Products	Discontinued products are products that had been introduced as applicable products in the previous technical bulletin; however, the product availability is currently low because of such as production discontinuation.

- The number of writings for CompactFlash cards is limited. For details, refer to the specifications of the product.
- Do not perform the following operations while accessing the CompactFlash card; powering OFF, restarting the CPU module, or removing the CompactFlash card. Doing so may cause data corruption in the card or file system error. Stop the file access before executing any of the above operations.
- Touch the grounded metal to discharge the electricity charged in your body before touching the CompactFlash card. Failure to do so may cause a failure or a malfunction on the CompactFlash card.
