Thank you for your continued support of Mitsubishi Integrated FA Software MELSOFT series.

When Windows Desktop Search is used, GX Works2 projects may not be saved properly due to coexistence with Windows Desktop Search. In this case, the project that has not been saved properly cannot be opened. This bulletin explains the symptoms and corrective actions on the failure mentioned above.

When GX Works2 Version 1.49B or earlier is used: \rightarrow Refer to 1. When GX Works2 Version 1.53F or later is used: \rightarrow Refer to 2.

If the problem is not solved by the troubleshooting described in this Technical Bulletin, refer to the following Technical Bulletin as well. It describes the troubleshooting for when a GX Works2 project cannot be saved normally.

1. When GX Works2 Version 1.49B or earlier is used

1.1 Symptom

(1) When "Save" or "Save As" is executed in GX Works2 project with a computer in which Windows Desktop Search is activated, the dialog box shown below may appear, and the project may not be saved.

•	The project cannot be saved in the specified path. The following are the possible causes: - The folder path does not exist. - A root directory is specified in the folder path. - The specified folder has read-only access. - Insufficient memory to save. - The specified drive is broken. - Other errors occurred during save. - Characters such as "*/:<>?\ ,; are used in the folder path or "." is used at the end of the folder name. Please temporarily save the project in a different drive using "Save As". OK		

- (2) If "Save" or "Save As" is executed again after (1), the dialog box shown above will not appear.
- (3) If the project is closed after (2), and opened again, the dialog box shown below appears and the project will not be opened.



1.2 Corrective action

Update the version to 1.53F or later, and refer to "2. When GX Works2 Version 1.53F or later is used"

If the version cannot be updated to 1.53F or later, disable the Windows Search Service to avoid the symptom. (Refer to 1.3 Workaround)

1.3 Workaround

Disable Windows Desktop Search following the procedure shown below. The following instruction is for Windows XP Service Pack 3 as an example.

(1) Stop the Windows Search Service.

Operate the following procedure with a user having the administrator authority.

- i. Click the start button, and click [Run].
- ii. Enter the command shown below on the displayed [Run] dialog box, and click the OK button. services.msc /s
- iii. After the following screen appears, double-click [Windows Search] on the list.

- vi. Click the OK button to close the [Windows Search Properties (Local Computer)] screen.
- vii. Click the X button to close the [Services] screen.

(2) Disable the Windows Search Service at Windows startup

i. Click the start button, and select [All Programs]⇒[Startup]. Right-click [Windows Search], and select [Delete].



(3) Right-click the Windows Search icon in the task tray shown below, select [Exit].



- (4) Restart the PC.
- (5) Open the [Services] screen following the procedure (1) i, ii, then check the [Status] of [Windows Search] on the list is other than "Started".

2. When GX Works2 Version 1.53F or later is used

2.1 Symptom

(1) When "Save", or "Save As" is executed on a GX Works2 project with a computer in which Windows Desktop Search is activated, either of the dialog boxes shown below may appear, and the project may not be saved.



2.2 Corrective action

The following procedure should restore the project data with the dialog box shown above opened. The following shows the example when Windows XP Service Pack3 is used.

(1) Open the folder of the GX Works2 project to be saved with Windows Explorer.

Example

Save destination:	C: \Documents and Settings\User\ Desktop\New Folder
Work destination:	Workspace
Project name:	Project

Open "C: \Documents and Settings\User\Desktop\New Folder\Workspace\Project" with Windows Explorer.

(2) Select "Rename" by right-clicking "_hdb.bak" from the folder.

(5) Select [Project] \rightarrow [Save] from Menu on GX Works2 to save the project.

(6) Close the project, and open the project again. If the project is opened normally, the project data is restored.

2.3 Workaround

If this symptom occurs frequently, disable Windows Desktop Search following the procedure written in 1.3 Workaround.
