



MITSUBISHI ELECTRIC secure two high rise buildings in London, UK

MITSUBISHI ELECTRIC is pleased to have been awarded contracts to supply the elevators in two high quality residential towers in London.

The company will supply 5 elevators for the tallest residential building in the UK at 50 stories (181m). St George Tower is located in Vauxhall adjacent to the River Thames. This includes 3 x NexWay units, high-speed custom type elevators, at 4.0m/s with bespoke edge-lit glass behind filigree panels and bronze trim and 2 x ELENESSA units, machine-room-less elevators. To aid the construction of the tower, Mitsubishi Electric will be using a jump lift installation method so that building workers can utilize elevator for vertical transportation during construction.

The second contract is The Heron for Heron International in the City. This is another high quality 36 story residential tower and also includes the redevelopment of the Guildhall School of Music & Drama. Mitsubishi Electric will install 3 x NexWay units at 3.5m/s in the residential tower including a bespoke destination control system at selected floors incorporating touch screens and extra security features. These lifts have particular architectural features including specialist marble finishes. Mitsubishi Electric will also install 2 x ELENESSA units; 1 x 4500kg hydraulic goods elevator; 5 x platform elevators and 1 x stair elevator.
