

Mitsubishi Electric announce approx. 100M JPY to help combat COVID-19 in Japan

Mitsubishi Electric Corporation, Japan, announced it will contribute 100 million yen (approximately \$930,000) to support the activities of Japanese medical personnel at the forefront of the spread of infection in Japan, and to support children who are affected by the prolonged suspension of school.

This joint donation led by the company and the Mitsubishi Electric SOCIO-ROOTS Fund recognizes the selfless commitment the medical staff and the difficult conditions that children find themselves in.

This follows other COVID-19 donations already made in February to [China](#)^{#1} and more recently through [Mitsubishi Electric America Foundation](#)^{#2} this month.
