Thank you for your continued support of Mitsubishi Graphic Operation Terminal (GOT).

Affected by the Kumamoto Earthquake, we have shipped a GT27 model for which the liquid crystal display (LCD) is temporarily changed based on our company's BCP\*1.

We announce that now we are ready to ship a GT27 model with the liquid crystal display (LCD) that had been used before the Earthquake.

### 1. Target product

GT2710-STBA (GOT2000 series GT27 model, 10.4" SVGA, AC power supply)

#### 2. Details of change

The LCD of the target product is changed back to the LCD that had been used before June 2016 or earlier.

#### 3. How to check the target product

The target product has function version A.

<sup>t</sup> The target GT27 model for which the liquid crystal display (LCD) is temporarily changed has function version B (manufactured in June 2016 to September 2016).
