Thank you for your continued support of Mitsubishi Electric Graphic Operation Terminal (GOT). We will change the description on the rating plate and remove the battery caution plate for GT25 wide models (10.1 and 7 inches) so that the GOTs will comply with the UL standards. The changes do not affect the general specifications, performance specifications, functions, and external dimensions of the GOTs.




### 2. Change details


#### 2.1 Rating plate

The caution mark will be added on the bottom right of the rating plate.

**2.2 Battery caution plate**

The caution plate will be removed from the back side of the battery cover on the GOT rear face. The description on the caution plate will be found in the enclosed general description of the GOT.

The change will be made sequentially from the February 2021 production. Applicable models may have the former plates or the new plate in the distribution stage.
