We inform you about the considerations due to the specification changes in middleware installed on a MELSOFT product.

1 OVERVIEW OF CHANGES

This chapter explains the specification changes in middleware of a MELSOFT product.

Due to the changes, a problem may occur depending on the combination of versions of MELSOFT products installed on the same personal computer. Check the considerations for installation before using the product.

Page 1 CONSIDERATIONS FOR INSTALLATION



The same middleware are used in multiple MELSOFT products.

MELSOFT products installed on the same personal computer share middleware.


When installing a newer version product, middleware of the existing MELSOFT product installed on the same personal computer is overwritten, thus the product operation is affected.

1.1 SCHEDULE

The specification will be changed for the product released in April 2020 and later.

2 CONSIDERATIONS FOR INSTALLATION

When installing a MELSOFT product of which the specifications in middleware are changed, the following screen appears.



Update the following products installed on the same personal computer to the supported version.
