Precautions regarding comments used in robot programs

Thank you for your continued support of Mitsubishi Electric industrial robot "MELFA". This technical news describes precautions regarding comments used in robot programs.

1 Precautions

In an environment where CR800-R/Q or CR860-R/Q is connected to R86TB, some Chinese characters written in robot program comments are incorrectly displayed as "¥" symbols, as shown in the figure on the right. Each time the robot program is opened with R86TB, the number of "¥" symbols increases.

When the number of "¥" symbols continues to increase and the total number of characters in a single program line exceeds 240, an L4210 error occurs.

2 Handling methods

To resolve this issue, we recommend modifying the robot program comments to avoid using the affected Chinese characters.

Once the solution to prevent this issue has been completed, we will revise this technical news accordingly and provide updated information.
