




## COLLECTOR-EMITTER SATURATION VOLTAGE CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




# FREE-WHEEL DIODE FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




# CAPACITANCE CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




## GATE CHARGE CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)



# HALF-BRIDGE SWITCHING ENERGY CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




# HALF-BRIDGE SWITCHING ENERGY CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




## HALF-BRIDGE SWITCHING ENERGY CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




## HALF-BRIDGE SWITCHING ENERGY CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)



# HALF-BRIDGE SWITCHING TIME CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)








### FREE-WHEEL DIODE REVERSE RECOVERY **CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)**

### TRANSIENT THERMAL IMPEDANCE CHARACTERISTICS








### **REVERSE BIAS SAFE OPERATING AREA** (RBSOA)




### SHORT CIRCUIT SAFE OPERATING AREA (SCSOA)
