


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#### PRECAUTIONS FOR TESTING

- Before applying any control supply voltage (VD), the input terminals should be pulled up by resistors, etc. to their corresponding supply voltage and each input signal should be kept off state.
   After this, the specified ON and OFF level setting for each input signal should be done.
- 2. When performing "SC" tests, the turn-off surge voltage spike at the corresponding protection operation should not be allowed to rise above VCES rating of the device.

(These test should not be done by using a curve tracer or its equivalent.)






Fig. 3 Switching time and SC test circuit




Fig. 4 Switching time test waveform




Fig. 5 Ices Test





Fig. 6 SC test waveform

Fig. 7 Dead time measurement point example



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


Fig. 8 Application Example Circuit


#### NOTES FOR STABLE AND SAFE OPERATION;


- Design the PCB pattern to minimize wiring length between opto-coupler and IPM's input terminal, and also to minimize the stray capacity between the input and output wirings of opto-coupler.
- ●Connect low impedance capacitor between the Vcc and GND terminal of each fast switching opto-coupler.
- Fast switching opto-couplers: tPLH, tPHL ≤ 0.8μs, Use High CMR type.
- Slow switching opto-coupler: CTR > 100%
- Use 4 isolated control power supplies (VD). Also, care should be taken to minimize the instantaneous voltage charge of the power supply.
- Make inductance of DC bus line as small as possible, and minimize surge voltage using snubber capacitor between P and N terminal.
- Use line noise filter capacitor (ex. 4.7nF) between each input AC line and ground to reject common-mode noise from AC line and improve noise immunity of the system.





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


# SWITCHING LOSS CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




# DIODE REVERSE RECOVERY CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




# SWITCHING RECOVERY LOSS CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




ID VS. fc CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)
