





- Case temperature ( $T_C$ ) and heat sink temperature ( $T_s$ ) are defined on the each surface (mounting side) of base plate and heat sink just under the chips.  
Refer to the figure of chip location.
- Pulse width and repetition rate should be such that the device junction temperature ( $T_{vj}$ ) does not exceed  $T_{vjmax}$  rating.
- Junction temperature ( $T_{vj}$ ) should not increase beyond  $T_{vjmax}$  rating.





Example of application (Short circuit detection & protection)






Short circuit detection & protection diagram






Switching characteristics test circuit and waveforms(x: connected a\* and b\*)

Qc test waveform




MOSFET Turn-on switching energy




MOSFET Turn-off switching energy




OUTPUT CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)




SOURCE-DRAIN ON STATE VOLTAGE




TRANSIENT THERMAL IMPEDANCE CHARACTERISTICS (MAXIMUM)
